The AHEPA Scholarship Perpetual Fund, Inc. has scholarship programs, which were established to promote, encourage, induce and advance education currently. The scholarship foundation will accept applications from graduating high school seniors, College/University students, and high school seniors vocational training.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

The applicant is the **son** or **daughter** [or grandson or granddaughter] of a chapter member of AHEPA in District Six in good standing at least two years prior to the application date of September 30, 2020.

#### OR

The applicant is a member of a Sons of Pericles chapter in District Six and is in good standing for at least two years prior to the application deadline date of September 30, 2020.

#### AND

The applicant MUST ATTEND **full time** (minimum 12 college credits), at an accredited college or university during the current calendar year 2020-2021 or attend a vocational school. The applicant must not have been a previous college/university recipient of this Scholarship Program.

The applicant must reside in the AHEPA Empire State District 6 domain, but can attend a college or university out of state.

#### AND

All recipients must provide proof by September 2020 that they are a full-time college student or attending a vocational program (Bursar's receipt) or a college transcript with a school seal.

#### **CREDENTIALS**

AHEPA HS Scholarship – a. (Grand) father must be in good standing with the AHEPA Empire State District 6 for at least two years, b. You must be a <u>high school senior</u>, c. Certification from the school registrar acknowledging your full time status, d. Submit Scholastic Aptitude Test (administered by the College Entrance Examination Board or American College Test/American College Training Program), e. Submit high school transcripts or comparable grades, f. You must reside in the AHEPA Empire District 6 domain.

AHEPA College/University Scholarship – a. (Grand) father must be in good standing with the AHEPA Empire State District 6 for at least two years or b. You must be <u>a full-time student (Freshman-Senior)</u>, c. Minimum 12 semester hours at an accredited college or university, d. Certification from the school registrar acknowledging your full-time status, e. Submit your college transcripts, f. You must reside in the AHEPA Empire District 6 domain but can be attending a College/University outside of District 6 domain.

**AHEPA HS Senior Vocational Training – a**. (Grand) father must be in good standing with the AHEPA Empire State District 6 for at least two years, **b**. You must be a <a href="https://example.com/high-school-senior">high school-senior</a>, **c**. Certification from the school registrar acknowledging your full-time status, d. Submit high school transcripts or comparable grades, **e**. You must reside in the AHEPA Empire District 6 domain, **f**. Please indicate the vocational institution you will attend.

#### **TRANSCRIPTS**

High school seniors must submit the most recent official complete high school transcript **AND SAT or ACT scores**. **All transcripts must be official and submitted as part of the complete application**. Applicants should provide the name of the college, university or vocational school to which they have been accepted or planning to attend.

College students must submit their transcripts from an accredited college or university. Transcripts must be official and submitted as part of the complete application.

All recipients must provide proof by October 15, 2020 that they are full time students by either a bursar's receipt or a college transcript with a school seal to be sent to Scholarship Committee Chairman: Basil Katsamakis 60 Sutton Place S. Apt. 4ES, New York, NY 10022.
